A Mixed-method Study on Examining the Living Conditions and Security as well as privacy issues among Bangladeshi college students

Hygienic, secure, and safe living conditions are essential in order to develop the cognitive construction of students positively and related to their academic performances. As per knowledge of the researchers, study on residential conditions of college students in Bangladesh, more specifically in Mymensingh, were rarely studied, although few studies were conducted among university students. Therefore, the current study aimed to discover the real situations about living conditions of college students and to examine the association between place of residence and safety issues as well as privacy issues. This study employed sequential explanatory mixed method among college students in Mymensingh city due to its familiarity of educational institutions. Using convenience sampling techniques, data was collected from 277 students for quantitative analysis, and 12 in-depth case interviews were conducted to gain in-depth understanding. Quantitative and qualitative data were analyzed using SPSS version 20 and thematically respectively. The findings of the study revealed that majority of the respondents, rated food quality as 'average' (50.2%), reported the area as moderately clean (54.5%), had uninterrupted clean drinking water (49.8%), had no common rooms (78.7%) and place of residence was robustly associated with the privacy ($\chi^2=52.32$; $p=.001$) as well as safety issues ($\chi^2=172.36$; $p=.001$). In the present study, qualitative findings also supported the quantitative findings. The findings suggest that the college authority or hostel authority should take initiative for improving the common room facilities, food quality, and clean drinking water. On the other hand, the students should take some responsibility to clean the living conditions.
